BLESSED ARE YOU

How to read the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12)

A chiasm (from the Greek letter *chi*, X) is a literary structure where ideas are arranged in a mirrored pattern—like looking at them in reverse order. The first idea connects to the last, the second to the second-to-last, and so on, often highlighting the central idea as the main point.

Pattern:

A – B – C – B' – A'

Simple example:

"When the going gets tough, the tough get going."

The structure helps with emphasis, memory, and meaning, and it's especially common in biblical texts, where the middle element often carries the theological weight.

Matthew 5:1-12

¹Seeing the crowds, [Jesus] went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him.

²And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:

³Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

⁴Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

⁵Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

⁶Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

⁷Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.
